What is Inter-University Exchange Project?

This project was launched by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology of Japan (MEXT) in 2011 with the aim of supporting international educational collaboration between universities in the target countries and regions that strategically accept Japanese and foreign students to study abroad, while guaranteeing the quality of higher education, with the aim of developing global human resources who can play an active role on the international stage and strengthening the global development capabilities of university education.

Utsunomiya University was adopted in FY 2020, and will receive support for five years until FY 2024 to implement the project.

Program objective

This program, "Programme for Developing Human Resource to Contribute to SDGs byMerging African Potential and Japanese Scientific Technology," aims to develop human resources who can contribute to the achievement of the SDGs through exchange programs between Utsunomiya University and six partner universities in Africa.

Overview of Study Abroad at Utsunomiya University

Application Requirements

- Graduate student in the Master' s Course at partner universities
- Student who has the English ability to keep up with classes in English at the time of study abroad

Period of study abroad

Short-term: 1 month, Long-term: 3 months to less than 1 year

Credit Transfer

The credits earned at the study abroad destination will be recognized as completion credits through mutual recognition

Assistance with study abroad expenses

As a scholarship, 80,000 JPY per month will be provided. We also plan to provide support for travel expenss, so you will not have to bear much of your own expenses.
