## We visit the rose farm every year with our customers.













Carbon offset program

We calculate how much CO2 is produced by growing and shipping roses, we offset the CO2 by donating Kenyan NGO which plant trees. (1ton of CO2 = 1tree)

Our customers can participate this action by adding 5 cents each rose.
